About Gift Aid

1. To qualify for Gift Aid you must have paid enough UK Income and/or Capital Gains Tax to cover the amount that all charities and Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASC) you donate to will reclaim for that tax year. Council Tax and VAT do not count. Please notify us if your circumstances change and you no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains.
2. We will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 that you have given (28p on every pound given for donations up to 5 April 2008). If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief via your Self-Assessment tax return (currently 25p for each pound you give).
3. You may cancel this declaration at any time by writing to us.
